# Checklist

### 1. Check Technical Requirements

- Ensure your computer meets the technical requirements for optimal performance.
- Technical Requirements:

• For the best performance, the Online School should be used on the current or previous major releases of Chrome®, Firefox®, Edge®, or Safari®. The Online School runs on Windows®, Mac®, Linux®, iOS®, Android®, or any other device with a modern web browser.

• The Online School requires an operating system that can run the latest compatible web browsers. Your computer operating system should be kept up to date with the latest recommended security updates and upgrades. For the best performance, access the Online School with a computer that supports the most recent browser versions. It is recommended to use a computer five years old or newer with at least 1GB of RAM.
